**Special regulations:** according to IGF (published in "Das Fjordpferd" No. 109, 04/00) **influenza vaccination is mandatory for competition horses!** i.e. basic immunisation and then at least annual vaccination against influenza.

Each Fjord horse is allowed 3 starts per day, up to 5 starts are permitted when participating in leisure competitions,

Each rider/driver is allowed 2 starts in each WB and each Fjord horse may only start once in each WB. With the exception of WB 4-6, where each Fjord horse may start twice or three times with different participants.

In addition, in classes 4-6, 10, 13, 18 and 19 each participant may only start once.

All horses must be 6 years old and older to participate in the championships and a copy of the breeding papers must be sent with the entry form.**

### **37. Test analogue to the nationwide leisure horse championships**

Participants: Riders of all age groups from 12 years and older.

The test consists of 4 parts (A-D).

Horse equipment: Saddle (English saddle), snaffle (for all riding styles). Gaiters allowed. No auxiliary reins. Exception: sliding ring martingale permitted as part of the group cross-country ride.

Rider equipment: according to WBO, suitable sturdy footwear (ankle-high, small heel). Helmet with three or four-point fastening, gloves. A whip is permitted (max. 75cm including the whip).

impact) and spurs with a maximum spike length of max. 3.5 cm with smooth end surfaces (without wheels), which are not suitable for causing stabbing or cutting injuries during normal use. The spur must be buckled in such a way that the spike is orientated horizontally or inclined downwards.

Group cross-country ride: protective waistcoat compulsory.

Judging: This combined WB consists of WB 50 A-D. Scores from 0-10 (half scores are permitted), part A-C judging procedure, WBO WB 244/266, part D observational judging procedure WBO WB 202.

Marks or points are awarded for the following characteristics and weighted as follows (in brackets): Part WB A: one mark for rideability task (x1); Part WB B: one mark each for walk (x1), trot (x1), canter (x1); Part WB C: one mark for rideability/jumping ability (x1), one mark for behaviour in the group (x1); Part WB D: one achieved score: maximum score 10 minus penalty points (x2). The addition of the individual scores or points gives the final result.

#### A Rideability competition:

Task (by heart): Square 20x40m / Duration: approx. 2 minutes (A-X)

Riding in at centre pace. Hold centre. Greeting. Riding in medium walk (G). Trot in front of the short side at working pace, light trot (C) right hand (K-X-M). Change through the whole arena.

Riding out in front of the short side (C-X-C) Canter left at working pace in the centre of the short side and ridden on the circle (1 round). (C) Centre of the short side working trot and (C-X-A) change out of the circle. (A) Canter to the right in working canter in the centre of the short side, full circle (1/2 time round). (C) Centre of the short side working trot. (M) After the short side, medium walk. (B) Centre of the long side turn right. (G) Halt in front of the judges, salute. Leave the arena in medium walk on long reins.

#### B Basic gait test WB

The horses will compete in groups of 2-4 horses for a gait assessment as part of the group cross-country ride, the horses will be presented as instructed by the judges. There is one score each for walk, trot and canter. No jumps or extended gaits are required.

#### C Group cross-country WB

Task: The horses are presented in groups of up to 4 riders over the entire arena at trot and canter with alternating tete (to be announced). They then individually complete 3 fixed jumps up to a maximum height of 60cm. Two scores are awarded: one for rideability in the gaits and at the jump, and one for behaviour in the group (obedience and temperament). Deduction for the 1st disobedience: 1.0 / deduction for the 2nd disobedience: 2.0 / deduction for the 3rd disobedience: 2.0; each obstacle must be ridden 3 times. After the 3rd disobedience, the ride continues at the next obstacle. Falling leads to disqualification. Duration: approx. 10 minutes / Group.

#### D Obedience competition

Tasks: Mounting with mounting aid. Dismounting in a marked lane and lifting the right front hoof. Then mount with a mounting aid, then stand still for approx. 5 seconds.

Starting at a walk. Pole maze and backing up: pass through a pole maze before leaving the maze, back up one horse length, then leave the maze at a walk. Canter and halt: canter on the circle from trot at a predetermined point, ride the whole Bahn. Canter into a marked corral and ride inside the corral.

Parry through the marker via trot to halt. Stand still for approx. 10 seconds. Start at a walk. Water tarpaulin: Riding over a tarpaulin covered with water at a walk. Rappelsack: a jute bag filled with tin cans is pulled over obstacles (e.g. stones) placed on the ground by a helper. Turning circle: turning inside a turning circle around a parasol placed in the centre with movable ribbons attached to the corners. The

Course outline will be sent after the closing date for entries. Riders must walk between and during the individual tasks, unless otherwise specified. Observed judging procedure. Maximum score 10, from which the respective penalty points will be deducted. Touching and crossing a marker / boundary: deduction of 0.5 penalty points, deduction for 1st disobedience: 0.5 penalty points; deduction for 2nd disobedience: 1.0 penalty point; deduction for 2nd disobedience: 1.0 penalty point.

3rd disobedience: 2.0 penalty points. After the third disobedience: continuation of the course at the next obstacle. If the maximum time set is exceeded or 0 points are scored, the judge may terminate the continuation of the course.

Participants: IGF members starting in **tests 10+27+35** and **not in test 41** participate. Only one Fjord horse is allowed per participant.

#### **43. Combined classification for re-entrants**

Participants: IGF members 30 years and older who start in **classes 7 and 33**. Only 1 Fjord horse is allowed per participant.  
Judging by addition of the placing numbers in the individual tests. Stake: 10,00€ VN:5

#### **44. Team competition (formerly country comparison)**

Participants: all age groups, IGF members, riders or drivers who have competed in **classes 7 + 19 + 33** start. Only one Fjord horse is allowed per participant. A team consists of 3-4 riders. The best 3 scores in each of the partial tests are added together. A team will remain in the classification even if not all riders remain in the classification in the individual tests.
